Dear Parent's/Guardians,

At this week's board meeting, the King City R-1 Board of Education approved the administration's request to make up those missed days as follows:

May 16<sup>th</sup>

May 17<sup>th</sup> (Currently the last day of school. 12:15 dismissal.)

The earlier calendar called for an early out for spring parent teacher conferences, but the revised calendar does not call for a special day for conferences. All make-up days will be a full day of school except May 17<sup>th</sup> as long as it is the last day of school.

The principal's in both buildings will be working with teachers to create a plan for meeting with parents regarding conferences. In turn, teachers will contact parents regarding a spring conference.

As we move closer to March, it is my hope the ice and snow will soon be behind us.
