Positive Energy – Skilled Trades – Scholarship 2023-2024

Description

The Lost Creek Wind Positive Energy Scholarship is intended to support students who have improved the lives of those around them in their community and who have gone above and beyond expected practices. The scholarship is presented to high school seniors who show promise in an area of skilled labor or trade. Scholarships are awarded on a competitive basis.

Award

A one-time scholarship toward tuition and educational expenses.

Student Eligibility Requirements

The Positive Energy Scholarship is designated for high schools within a school district either partially or fully located in a county where the Lost Creek Wind energy facility is operated. The total amount of the \$2,000 will be split evenly between two scholarship recipients each year. However, if two eligible students do not apply, the full base amount maybe awarded to a single student.

The scholarship is intended for 12th grade seniors progressing normally toward graduation and planning to enter a trade school program, no later than January of 2025. The student should possess a clear goal of desiring to make his/her community, environment or world a better and more sustainable place to live. Judging will be based on a number of factors, including:

- A minimum GPA of 2.0
- Acceptance to a technical school, trade school, or skilled labor program
- History of community involvement and participation in extracurricular activities
- A strong potential for a success

Applicants will not be discriminated against on the basis of sex, race, religion or national origin. Residence within the project boundary will not increase or decrease a student's chances of receiving the scholarship.

Required Materials

The deadline to apply is **April 1, 2024**

- Enclosed application form
- Description of your involvement in your community and school
- Description of extracurricular activities
- One letter of recommendation
- A One-paragraph describing:
 - How you chose your intended field
