Dear Parents/Guardians,

Track and Field Day is quickly approaching. It will be held Friday May 5<sup>th</sup>, 2017. If weather does not permit us to have it that day, a text alert will go out by 7:45am that morning. Monday May 8<sup>th</sup>, 2017 will be our rain date. We will be performing our events and races around the football field, so feel free to watch from the bleachers, or you may follow your child to their events. We will ask that we limit the traffic on the football field please. Grades K-3 will participate from 8:30-10:30am and grades 4-6 from 12:30-2:30pm. If time allows, there will be a short assembly, to distribute awards, at the end of the day, approximately 2:30. Your child has signed up and practiced for their events during their PE classes. Each student will get a reminder slip listing their events the day of the track meet.

Please make sure that your child will have a pair of tennis shoes to wear for that day, as it won't be safe to allow them to participate in flip flops or sandals. The morning session may be a little cooler than the afternoon, so please dress your child accordingly. Also, you may send water bottles and sunscreen with your child as needed. Please make sure your child's classroom teacher is aware if you plan to eat lunch with your child so our staff can prepare enough food.

I will be sending out a tentative schedule of the times and event order closer to the date of May 5<sup>th</sup>. We would love for you to come and support your child during this fun day.
